Socially Responsible Investing Committee: The GSO voted to add our support to the Socially Responsible Investing statement that will be presented to the BU Board of Trustees. This group is made up of BU students and faculty that are concerned with achieving transparency of BU's investments and assuring that they meet ethical standards. The group is working toward establishing a committee with the capacity to recommend divestment of and abstension from investments in companies that act illegally and unethically.

Cosponsored Event Application: The GSO voted to grant an additional \$100 to the BU Music Society Graduate Student Conference. This additional award brings the total GSO support for this event to \$400.
