REQUIRED COURSES

Students enroll in the following three, 4-credit courses:

- CAS LS 305 Topics in Language and Culture: Spanish Through TV Series
- CAS SP 342 Spanish Film
- CAS FT 552 Documentary Video Production

ELECTIVE COURSE

Students also choose one four-credit course from those offered in the broader Boston University Madrid program.

Madrid Film Studies and Documentary Video Production Program

This unique Madrid program combines advanced coursework in language and culture studies through Spanish film and television with a rare opportunity to investigate the changing cultural landscape of contemporary Spain through a documentary video production course. The program is open to upperclassmen with an advanced level of Spanish language, regardless of major.

The mixture of film and non-film majors is beneficial to the process of story selection as well as adding perspectives to the documentary production itself. The production course is taught by Almudena Sanchez, an accomplished cinematographer and graduate of the world famous International Film School in Havana, Cuba. Students edit and complete their film at a professional post-production house in the heart of Madrid.

Upon successful completion of the semester, students earn 16 Boston University credits.

HOUSING

All Madrid students are placed in Spanish households, where they have their own room and take meals with their hosts.

ADMISSIONS

- Open to students who have completed a minimum of fifth-semester college level Spanish or the equivalent.
