London Liberal Arts Program

London is busy, noisy and fascinating. Home to over seven million people with communities from every corner of the earth, it has a unique mixture of history and cutting edge culture. It is home to writers, politicians, artists, musicians and designers making London a fast moving cosmopolitan experience for visitors and residents.

Boston University's London Summer Liberal Arts program provides an opportunity to study the many facets of contemporary British culture with courses on the British media, arts, literature, politics, economy, constitutional law, and social policy. The program also offers courses on graphic design, advertising, marketing, public relations, and tourism. Guest speakers and special excursions supplement the curriculum for both sessions. Students enroll in two elective courses for a total of eight credits.

Qualified students who successfully complete the program may apply to continue their summer studies through the London Internship Program. Students who wish to be considered for this option should consult with the London staff once overseas

HOUSING

Students live in furnished apartments with other students in Boston University's London programs. The apartments are within walking distance of the BU London Academic Center. They vary in size (from two to 13 occupants), configuration, and style of decoration, but most consist of shared bedrooms, bath/shower room, and a living/dining room with cooking facilities. Telephone and Internet access are provided in each of the apartments.
