London Acting Program (LAMDA)

Boston University's London Acting Program (LAMDA) offers Boston University College of Fine Arts students the opportunity to live and study in one of the world's most important cities for theatrical performance. The program is offered in conjunction with the London Academy of Music and Dramatic Arts (LAMDA), one of the leading drama schools in the English-speaking world.

This is a highly advanced professional acting program intended for students from conservatory-style acting programs. Students can enroll in LAMDA for their Spring Semester Classical Acting course as full-time students. Students on this programme study Shakespearean and Restoration theatre along with the disciplines of voice, movement, period dance, stage combat, acting and textual analysis. The programme is complemented by regular attendance of theatre performances and a trip to Stratford-upon-Avon. The students finish their coursework at LAMDA with a final performance. www.bu-london.co.uk

Upon successful completion of the program, students earn 16 Boston University credits.
