Students are required to take a full course load (16 credits) during their semester in Dublin.

The Dublin Internship Program has a two-part semester calendar. For the first part of the semester, you will take two required four-credit core courses: SO 341: Contemporary Irish Society and either HI325/PO381: History of Ireland or SAR HS 422: Ethics in Health Care.

Upon successful completion of these intensive courses, you will begin the seven-week internship. Elective courses run throughout the entire duration of the program and meet once per week.
