HOST INSTITUTION

Bogazici University (Bosphorus University)

Located in Istanbul, the main part of this expansive campus sits on a hill overlooking the scenic Bosphorus Strait and is just minutes away from the shores of the Black Sea. Originally founded as "Robert College" in 1863, it was America's first college on foreign soil. With approximately 7,800 undergraduate students, Bosphorus's academic facilities, faculty housing, and student dormitories are situated on this campus of natural beauty. As one of Turkey's most competitive universities, Bosphorus University offers a wide array of programs, but its strengths lie in engineering, education, social sciences, natural science's, and the art's. www.boun.edu.tr

EXCHANGE PROGRAM

Boston University students have the opportunity to directly enroll at Bogazici University for a semester or an academic year. All courses are taught in English. Upon successful completion of a semester, students earn 12 to 20 Boston University credits.

EXCHANGE OVERVIEW

If you are seeking a highly independent and culturally immersed study abroad program, an exchange may be right for you. On an exchange program, you will enroll directly at one of our partner universities and take your classes with local students. This model offers levels of authenticity and autonomy that are not often available through other study abroad programs. Our exchange partners include prestigious institutions in several countries and most offer courses in English.

Participating in an exchange is affordable and simple: while you are participating on an exchange program, you will pay regular BU tuition to BU and your financial aid will apply as usual. Courses you take abroad will appear on your transcript as BU credits. Explore the exchange options below and contact Marisa Crowley to begin planning for your exchange.

HOUSING

Students live on campus in dormitory facilities. Arrangements for housing will be made in advance of travel to Turkey.

2014/2015 PROGRAM COST

Students will pay Boston University tuition for the semester or academic year that they are abroad. Participants pay separately for housing, board, airfare, and other incidentals. Emergency travel assistance coverage and overseas medical insurance are provided for students.
