### Auckland Management Internship Program

#### COURSES

Students enroll in one required course listed below, two management courses at the University of Auckland, and an internship placement.

CAS SS 315 Aotearoa New Zealand: History, Society, and Politics

Boston University Study Abroad and the School of Management offer SMG students an exciting opportunity to earn management credit and complete a four-credit internship in exotic Auckland, New Zealand. The Auckland Management Internship Program, offered both in the Fall and Spring semesters, allows students to directly enroll at the University of Auckland. Students complete two management courses, a course on the culture and history of New Zealand, and a four-credit internship arranged by the Boston University Auckland Center. Students pursuing the Fall Semester program will take courses during the University of Auckland's Semester II term. Students pursuing the Spring semester program will take courses during the University of Auckland's Summer and Semester I terms.
