



MADRID, SPAIN > STUDY ABROAD



Students looking to study in Madrid have several options to consider. They can participate in the Madrid Spanish Studies Program, Madrid Internship Program, Madrid Engineering Program, Madrid Science Program, or the Madrid Management Internship Program. Upon successful completion of a semester, students earn 16 to 20 Boston University credits.

Two programs are offered during the summer term: the Madrid Internship Program and the Madrid Spanish Studies Program.

Madrid Programs

MADRID ENGINEERING PROGRAM

Offered in the spring semester, this program combines coursework at the Universidad Autónoma de Madrid (UAM) and the Instituto Internacional. No prior knowledge of Spanish is required.

MADRID INTERNSHIP PROGRAM

Students enroll in three courses and an internship placement from more than 350 active internship sources. Internship placement is available to students proficient in Spanish (Levels II and III).

MADRID SPANISH STUDIES PROGRAM

Level I: Intensive Spanish Language Studies An intensive language and cultural immersion program held at the Instituto Internacional. Academic options are available for students who have completed second, third, or fourth semester college Spanish, or equivalent. Courses in Spanish.

Level II: Advanced Language Studies Level II offers students the opportunity to complement language study with liberal arts courses at the Instituto Internacional. Fifth-semester college Spanish or the equivalent required.

Level III: University Studies Level III offers a specialized program for exceptional students who have a strong command of Spanish and have taken sixth-semester Spanish or the equivalent. Students enroll directly in coursework at the UAM. Prior to the start of courses, students enroll in an advanced-level seminar on contemporary Spain. (Level III is offered spring semester only.)

MADRID MANAGEMENT INTERNSHIP PROGRAM

Students directly enroll in the UAM and take three courses and an internship placement. Minimum of six semesters of college-level Spanish is required. (Offered spring semester only.)

MADRID SCIENCE PROGRAM

The Madrid Science Program, offered in fall semester, combines coursework at the UAM and the Instituto Internacional. No prior knowledge of Spanish is required.

HOUSING

All Madrid students are placed in Spanish households, where they have their own room and take meals with their hosts.

\$29,858 per semester. Cost includes tuition, housing, board, field trips, internship placement (if applicable), round-trip airfare from designated US cities, local transportation allowance, pre-approved or selected limited cultural reimbursements, emergency travel assistance coverage, and overseas medical insurance. Financial aid is available.
