Venice Studio Arts Program

The Venice Studio Arts Program offers students immersion in the most extraordinary artistic city in the world, whose museums, walkways, and canals form a truly unique classroom. The program is hosted in the beautiful Boston University Academic Center close to Campo Santa Margherita where, in addition to classrooms, students profit from wide and bright studio space.

Courses are taught by local faculty as well as by visiting faculty from Boston University. Students take art history, beginning Italian language, and painting or graphic design in a dynamic setting.

Excursions to major Italian cities, such as Florence, Bologna, Padua or Vicenza, as well as visits to local monuments, museums and galleries complement the curriculum. Through the Tandem Learning Exchange, students also have the opportunity to meet and interact with peers and local artists from the Venice Fine Arts Academy.

Upon successful completion of the program, students earn 16 to 20 Boston University credits.

REQUIRED COURSES

All students enroll in the following courses:

- Venetian Renaissance Art and Architecture
- First-Semester Italian
- Graphic Design and Typography OR Painting

ELECTIVE COURSES

Students choose one or two additional courses from the following electives:

- Drawing Venice
- Glassblowing
- Printmaking (Intaglio and woodcutting)



HOUSING

Students stay in furnished apartments in Venice.

Fall Semester: early September–mid-December
Spring Semester: mid-January–mid-May

ADMISSIONS
