The Health Science Track of the Dublin Internship Program is ideal for students interested in pre-med, public health, PT/OT and nursing. Based at Dublin City University (DCU), the program combines a professional health-related internship with coursework on Ireland's contemporary culture, medical ethics, and healthcare system. Courses designed specifically for the program are taught by faculty drawn from Dublin-area universities and professional institutes.

Upon successful completion of the program, students earn 16 Boston University credits.

Dublin Internship Program: Health Science Track

COURSES

Core Phase (Required Courses)

For the first six weeks, students enroll in the following two, 4-credit courses.

SAR HS 422 Ethics in Health Care CAS SO 341 Contemporary Irish Society

Core Phase and Internship Phase (Required Course)

Students also take one, 4-credit course that runs over the duration of the program:

SAR HS 425 Health Care Policy and Practice in Ireland

Internship Phase

For the final seven weeks of the semester students participate in a four-credit health-related internship course while also continuing the health care policy course on Friday mornings.

Health-related internship areas include but are not limited to: pre-medical, nursing, public health, rehabilitation, health/human services, and therapy.

HOUSING

Students are housed in deluxe, suite-style accommodations on the campus of Dublin City University (DCU) in double rooms. Each bedroom is equipped with Internet access, a television, a study area, and its own bathroom. The suites feature full kitchens and seating areas, and are a short walk from BU's administrative offices, the DCU library, bookstore, and athletic facilities.
