Madrid Spanish Studies Program, Level II: Advanced Language Studies

The Madrid Spanish Studies Program offers a semester or academic year of intensive language and cultural study in the lively and cosmopolitan city of Madrid, Spain. The Madrid Level II track is for advanced Spanish students. Participants on this program need to have completed through fifth semester college-level Spanish, or the equivalent, prior to participation. Courses are taught exclusively in Spanish.

Upon successful completion of a semester, students earn 16 Boston University credits.

All courses are taught in Spanish at the Instituto Internacional en Espana. Level II Madrid students must take four courses to earn a total of 16 credits. Students interested in replacing one course with an internship should apply to the Madrid Internship Program.

HOUSING

All Madrid students are placed in Spanish households, where they have their own room and take meals with their hosts.

ADMISSIONS

- Completion of a minimum of fifth-semester college-level Spanish or equivalent

\$29,858 per semester. Cost includes tuition, housing, board, field trips, round-trip airfare from a designated US city, local transportation allowance, pre-approved or selected limited cultural reimbursements, emergency travel assistance, and overseas medical insurance. Financial Aid is available.
