COURSE DESCRIPTION:

This course consists of your field research, as reported in your lot forms and the final report on your excavations.

COURSE REQUIREMENTS:

Your final grade in this course will be determined by the quality of your lot forms (40%) and a final report on your excavations—to be divided into a graded rough draft (20%) and a final copy (40%). These reports should include an introductory section, stated objectives, an opening description of the area of inquiry followed by a comprehensive breakdown of each excavation unit, in which the unit itself should be detailed and each stratigraphic level described. A summary of all work done should be provided along with your own interpretations on what your excavated data tells us about the site. Collected data sets, maps, photographs, drawings, etc. should be included with your report in support of your descriptions and conclusions.
