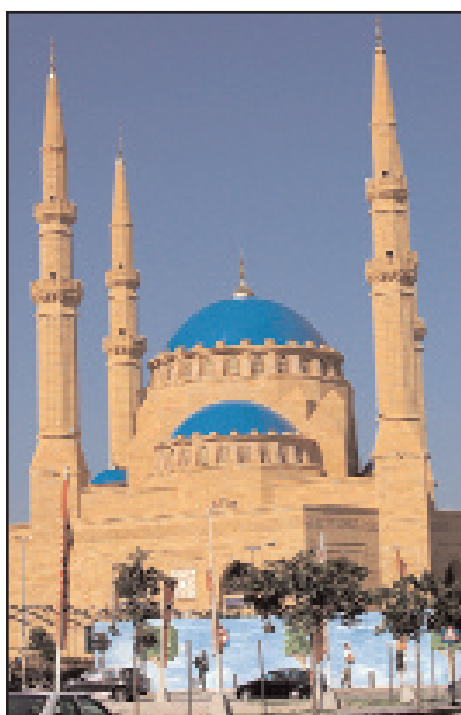




BEIRUT, LEBANON > STUDY ABROAD



Beirut: The American University of Beirut

Boston University students have the opportunity to study for a semester or an academic year at The American University of Beirut (AUB). This exchange program will be of interest to students in all undergraduate fields. There is no prior language requirement as the language of instruction is English. Limited places are available.

Upon successful completion of a semester, students earn 12 to 20 Boston University credits.

HOST INSTITUTION

The American University of Beirut (AUB)

AUB was founded in 1866 as a private, independent, non-sectarian institution of higher learning, functioning under a charter from the State of New York. It has grown from 16 students in a rented house to a major university with over 7,000 students located on a 73-acre campus overlooking the Mediterranean Sea.

AUB is home to approximately 1250 international students (carriers of non-Lebanese passports) from over 64 different countries. International Student Services (ISS) provides services to support international students.

HOUSING

Most students at AUB will stay in university dormitories.

Fall Semester: late September–late December
 Spring Semester: early February–early June

 Spring Semester: September 15

PROGRAM COST

Students will pay Boston University tuition for the semester or academic year that they are abroad. Participants pay separately for housing, board, airfare, and other incidentals. Emergency travel assistance coverage and overseas medical insurance are provided for the students.
