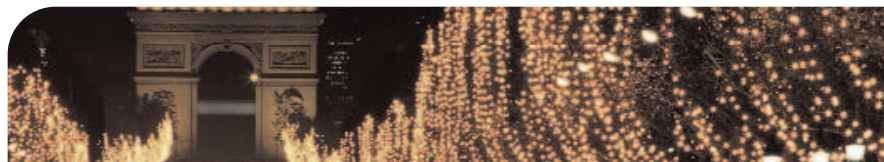

COURSES

Students enroll in one of the following four-credit courses and the internship course. All courses are taught in French. Students must enroll for a total of eight credits.

- CAS FR 300 Advanced Language Practicum
- CAS LF 342 Paris Aujourd'hui: French Society and Civilization through the Performing Arts
- CAS LF 343 La France à Paris: Paris in Literature

INTERNSHIP AREAS

Internship areas include advertising, marketing, and public relations; arts and arts administration; business and economics; film, radio, and television; health and human services; hospitality and tourism; journalism; management and finance; politics and international relations; pre-law; psychology and social policy; and theater studies.

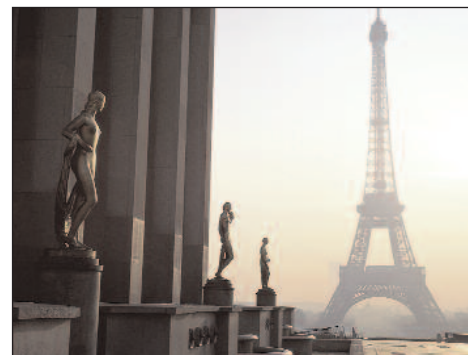
Paris Internship Program

The Paris Internship Program offers students the opportunity to spend eight weeks living, studying, and interning in Paris, known throughout the world as the magnificent City of Light. Students are introduced to the city's rich and vibrant culture in coursework which focuses on Paris through a study of literature, art and architecture, cinema, theatre, and culture.

Students enroll in one liberal arts course and participate in a professional internship. Courses are taught at the Boston University Paris

Academic Center, located in the fifteenth arrondissement within walking distance of the Eiffel Tower. Excursions to cultural sites within the city and beyond complement the coursework.

Upon successful completion of the program, students earn eight Boston University credits.



HOUSING

The Boston University Paris Academic Center, including administrative offices and classrooms, is located in the fifteenth arrondissement, within walking distance of the Eiffel Tower. Students are placed in a French household or in student housing at the Fondation des Etats-Unis, a residence hall in the Cité Universitaire international student complex. Boston University cannot guarantee students their first choice of housing.

- Open to students who have completed four or more semesters of college-level French, or the equivalent
