

Dublin Engineering Program

The Dublin Engineering Program offers upper division engineering students the opportunity to take technical and engineering courses through local university study at Dublin City University (DCU).

Students in the Dublin Engineering Program enroll directly in DCU, a modern and fast-growing university four miles north of the city center of Dublin, Ireland. www.dcu.ie

HOUSING
