DUBLIN, IRELAND > SUMMER ABROAD



The Boston University Summer internship program in Dublin, Ireland offers students the opportunity to spend eight weeks studying and interning in Dublin, one of Europe's most vibrant and cosmopolitan cities. Students combine a professional internship with one liberal arts course. Classes are held at Dublin City University (DCU) and are conducted by faculty from Dublin City University and other Dublin universities.

Upon successful completion of the summer program, students will receive a total of eight Boston University credits.

COURSES

Students enroll in one of the following, four-credit courses and an internship course:

CAS HI 325/PO 231 The History of Ireland
CAS SO 341 Contemporary Irish Society
Questrom FE 445: Investment Analysis and Portfolio Management

Internship Areas

Placements are contingent upon the student's past experience, professional interests, and available opportunities during the summer term, so flexibility is essential.

Internship areas include, but are not limited to: advertising or public relations, arts and architecture, broadcasting and film, business and economics, health and human services, hospitality administration, journalism, visual and performing arts, international organization, politics and comparative law.

HOUSING

Students are housed in double bedrooms in suite-style accommodations on the Dublin City University (DCU) campus, located four miles north of the city center. Each bedroom is equipped with Internet access and its own bathroom. Students have full access to the facilities and services of DCU. The suites feature full kitchens and seating areas, and are a short walk from BU's administrative offices, the DCU library, bookstore, and athletic facilities.
