Auckland Programs

The Auckland Programs offer students exciting options for study and internships in Auckland, New Zealand, the gateway to the South Pacific. The program is built around an extended direct enrollment semester at one of two major New Zealand universities—the University of Auckland and the Auckland University of Technology (AUT University). Students either enroll in the Auckland Internship Program or the Auckland University Studies Program. Students enjoy excellent coursework, the best internships in the business, and excursions that introduce them to the history and culture of this unique and beautiful country. Upon successful completion of the program, students earn 16 Boston University credits.

Program Structure

Auckland Internship Program

All students enroll in one required course, then enroll directly at the University of Auckland or AUT, depending on their specific field and interests. Students take two elective courses and complete an 8-10 week internship as their fourth and final course.

Housing

All program participants live in single bedrooms in furnished suites located in a vibrant urban environment, in the heart of Auckland and within walking distance of both universities. All program participants enjoy unlimited access to university facilities and sports and social activities.

Excursions

All students will enjoy two excursions to important cultural and historical sites within New Zealand.

University Studies Program
