Study Engineering in Australia and Ireland

## SYDNEY ENGINEERING PROGRAM

Students in the Sydney Engineering Program will enroll directly in the University of Sydney, a large, comprehensive university in the center of Sydney, Australia. Sydney Uni, as it is known, is one of Australia's most prestigious institutions of higher learning. [www.usyd.edu.au](http://www.usyd.edu.au).

Students enrolled in this program will typically choose three technical courses. In addition, students will enroll in one course on Australian culture and society. Students in the Sydney Engineering Program live with other BU program participants in Unilodge or other comparable, fully furnished student housing. Students have full access to the facilities and services of the University of Sydney.

## DUBLIN ENGINEERING PROGRAM

Students in the Dublin Engineering Program will enroll directly in Dublin City University, a modern and fast-growing university just north of the city center of Dublin, Ireland. [www.dcu.ie](http://www.dcu.ie).

Students enrolled in this program will choose three engineering courses, and one elective course offered by BU's Dublin Internship Program (Arts in Ireland or Modern Irish Literature). Students are housed in double bedrooms in suite-style accommodations on the Dublin City University Campus. Each bedroom is equipped with Internet access and its own bathroom. Students have full access to the facilities and services of Dublin City University.



## PROGRAM ADMINISTRATION

### Admissions

- Minimum 3.0 GPA (in major)
- Junior or senior standing in the Boston University College of Engineering
- Many courses carry prerequisites

### Program Dates

**Sydney:** Mid-July through Late November

**Dublin:** Late September through mid-December

(Students will take their final exams in January in Boston.)

### Application Deadline

**Fall Semester:** March 15

### Program Cost

**2008/2009 Tuition and Fees:** \$21,980 per semester.

Cost includes tuition, housing, round trip airfare, excursions, and emergency travel assistance coverage. Financial aid is available.
