

## WASHINGTON, D.C. MANAGEMENT INTERNSHIP PROGRAM

*Now take up to two Management courses at George Washington University!*

An internship placement for management students *may* include: the American Chamber of Commerce, the Organization for International Investment, multinational corporations, professional associations, the U.S. Department of Commerce, the Overseas Private Investment Corporation, the Senate Small Business and Entrepreneurship Committee, the House of Representatives Ways and Means Committee, or Senate and House of Representatives offices. (Please note, these are examples of past internship placements only. While we guarantee an internship to program participants, specific placements vary from semester to semester.)



### Location

A safe, comfortable place to live in a prestigious section of northwest Washington, D.C. close to restaurants, shops, and attractions.

### Housing

All apartments have three bedrooms which are furnished and centrally air conditioned, two bathrooms, fully equipped kitchens, and a common area. Apartments house six residents, and include cable television and high speed Internet access in each room.

### The Amenities

Residents can browse through daily newspapers and conduct research in the computer center. They also enjoy the convenience of laundry and vending services in the building as well as a full-time residence staff.



### Admissions

- Juniors and seniors who have at least a 3.0 GPA and advisor approval.

### Program Cost

2007/2008 Tuition and Fees: \$21,015 per semester. Includes tuition, housing, internship placement, excursions, a telecommunications fee, and emergency/travel assistance coverage. Financial aid is available.
