The Academy is accessible by the use of public transportation. Those wishing to take the subway can take the MBTA "B" Green Line to *BU Central*. Students taking the Commuter Rail will need to change to the Green Line at North Station or get off at Back Bay and walk down Dartmouth Street, past the main library, to Copley. **Student Pass Program -Trains and Buses.  
CONTAINS NEW INFORMATION FOR 2010 STUDENT PASSES.**

The MBTA offers two pass programs to high school students, which must be processed through the school. One is a pupil badge, which is free and gives the bearer half-fare on any MBTA service.

The other, the Student MBTA Pass which covers the Subway, Bus, and Commuter Rail Zones 1, 1a and 2, has changed since last year: it is now a Student CharlieCard with the Student MBTA Pass uploaded monthly to it. **Each student will be assigned a single card for the entire school year, so it is imperative that the card is not lost.** The pass will be \$20 per month, which is \$200 for the September 2009 – June 2010 school year; passes may be purchased for the full year or on a month by month basis with the card activated and deactivated by month.

If you would like to enroll in either program, please fill out the attached form and mail it in by July 20, 2009. *All checks should be made out to Boston University Academy.* **We must submit pass orders before August 1 in order to receive passes in September.**
