



Boston University Academy encourages applications from a wide variety of backgrounds, including homeschooled students. All homeschooled students are required to submit the traditional application for admission. While we apply an equal standard to all students, we recognize that homeschooled students have followed varied curricula. We request that homeschooled applicants submit the following information to aid the admissions committee:

### **Detailed Transcript**

Boston University Academy requests a detailed transcript for the last two years of academic work, as well as the current term. This transcript should include course names, the length of each course, the textbook(s) used in each course, the teacher's name for each course, and an evaluation. When possible, please provide the admission committee with syllabi. Please include the total number of years that you have homeschooled. It is not necessary for homeschooled applicants to submit the School Report.

### **Daily Schedule**

To better understand how each homeschooling experience is structured, we request a detailed, daily schedule for a typical week of school. Please describe any extra-curricular involvement with a local school or community.

### **Teacher Recommendations**

Boston University Academy requires that at least one of your recommendations is written by a non-family member. Please submit additional recommendations from teachers who have knowledge of the student's academic ability.
