

NOTICE TO ALL FELLOWSHIP APPLICANTS

The following items must be in your file to be considered for a fellowship at the African Studies Center. Incomplete files will automatically exempt you from consideration.

Incoming Students and New Applicants

- African Studies Center financial aid application
- A 250 word statement of interest. This statement should describe your specific interests in Africa and your career goals and plans.
- Two Letters of reference
- Transcripts from all colleges or universities previously attended TOEFL scores (TOEFL scores if TOEFL is required for admission to your program)
- GRE scores
- African Language Questionnaire (if applying for a FLAS)

Previous Applicants

- African Studies Center financial aid application
- Most recent transcript
- Progress report written by your advisor noting updated status of your coursework/qualifying exams/research proposal.
- African Language Questionnaire (if you are applying for a FLAS)

Policy on Incompletes

You will not be considered if you have two or more incompletes on your record resulting from failure to complete course requirements. You will be considered only prejudicially if you have one incomplete. Documents that are required at both the African Studies Center and the Graduate School may be submitted as photocopies to the African Studies Center.

Deadline: Submit application, transcripts, scores, letters, progress reports by February 15 for the following academic year.
