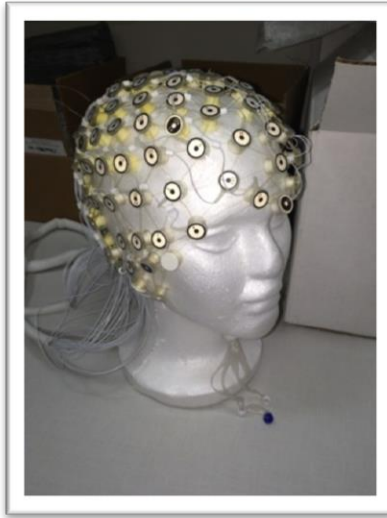
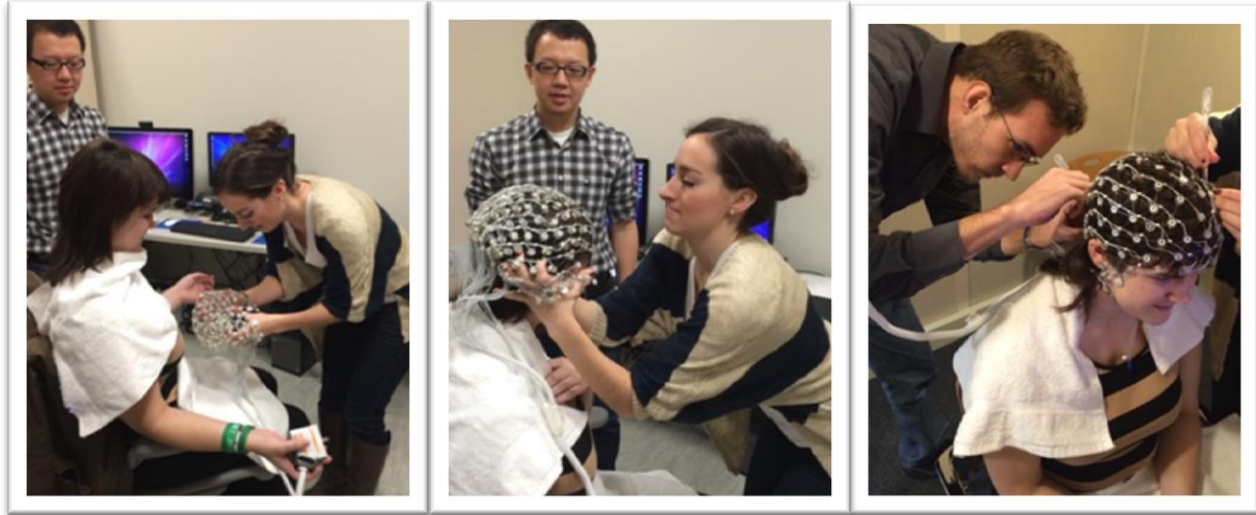




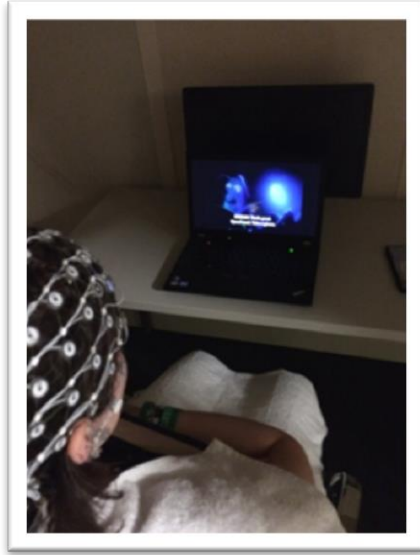
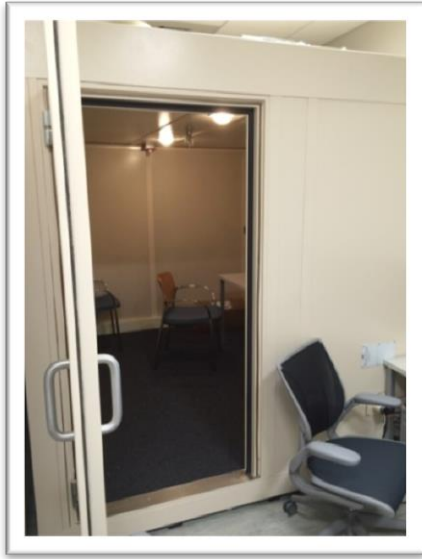
**My EEG at

University!**



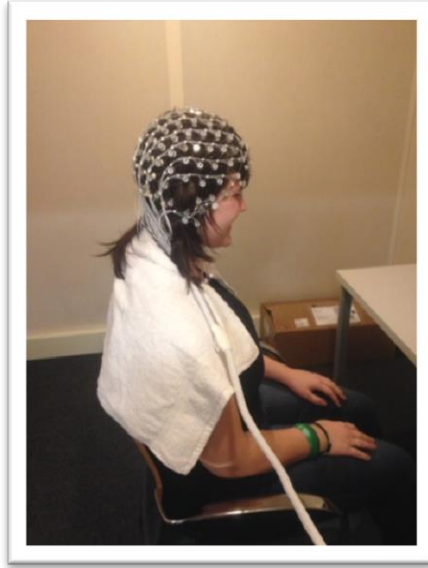
During my visit to Boston University, I will complete activities with researchers. One of the activities I complete is an EEG, which tells researchers how my brain processes words!



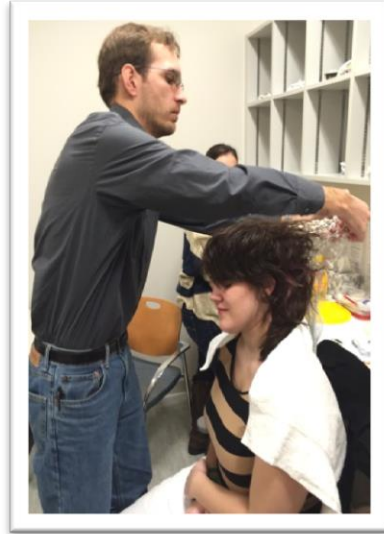
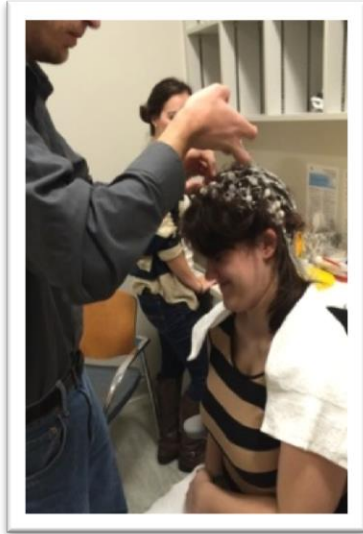
I will go to special room and sit down. I will try my best to sit still while researchers place a cap on my head. The cap might feel wet and tight, but it cannot hurt me.
