

FULBRIGHT GRANT

SUGGESTED TIMELINE FOR THE APPLICATION PROCESS

- Winter:
- Discuss your ideas and the appropriateness of the project with professors or scholars in the field.
 - Contact potential referees, advise them that you plan to apply for a Fulbright and ask if they are willing to write a recommendation for you.
- Spring:
- Read application and brochure carefully.
 - Choose a country based on your study/research interests and your language ability. Investigate the universities and colleges in that country to determine which has the best resources for your project.
 - Establish contact with potential host institutions to inquire about their resources and if you can work there. If possible, secure letter welcoming you and your project.
 - Also, if appropriate to your project, establish contact with research scholar or professor with whom you would like to work while at the institution. Keep a record of all correspondence to submit with application.
 - Begin writing the project description. This is a good time to assess your preparedness to carry out your project.
 - Prepare a resume (curriculum vitae) which will highlight areas of interest and qualifications not addressed in your project description.
 - Further any language training that will be helpful or necessary to carry out your project in the host country.
 - Write and re-write your project description.
 - Submit optional pre-application by June 3, 2002 or request Fulbright application.**
- Summer:
- Share your project description with advisor(s) or professors.
 - Distribute reference forms--including foreign language reference--to faculty who have agreed to provide recommendations for you. Be sure to include due date, and give the address where the recommendations must be sent to the University Fulbright and DAAD Committee, 145 Bay State Road, Boston, Massachusetts 02215.
- September:
- Complete Fulbright application for submission to the University Fulbright and DAAD Committee, 145 Bay State Road, Boston, Massachusetts 02215. **Applications are due by September 6, 2002.** All applicants will be interviewed by the Committee before the external deadline in mid-October.
