

Boston University Marine Program 2017 Warren-McLeod Fellowships for Graduate Research in Marine Science

	Warren-McLeod Award	Warren-McLeod Summer Research Fellowship
Award	12 months of support, including stipend plus tuition or continuation fees.	Summer stipend
Eligibility	Open to GRS PhD candidates who have completed the qualifying exam and are conducting research in marine science. Preference will be give to students that have completed coursework or plan no coursework during the year of the award.	Open to all students enrolled in GRS PhD programs who are conducting research in marine science. You need not have passed your qualifying exam.
Maximum duration of support	Students who have received the award once may re-apply, but no student will receive more than 2 years of support.	Students who have received the award once may re-apply, but no student will receive more than 2 summers of support.
Application*	 (1) A proposal describing the scholarly activities (research, data analysis, writing) that you will conduct during the time you are supported under the award. Do not exceed 5 pages including references and figures (single-spaced; 12 point font; 1-inch page margins). Your proposal should describe a "broader impact" of your research (such as an outreach or mentoring activity or production of an educational resource for the public). (2) Your curriculum vitae, which should summarize your training, research experience, and teaching experience, in addition to any previous awards, publications (in print, in press, in review, and in preparation), and presentations at scientific conferences. (3) Reprints or preprints of publications. (4) A copy of your graduate academic transcript. (5) A letter of recommendation from your principal advisor. Save your entire application in a single .pdf document. The first page of this document should be the Warren-McLeod Fellowship Application cover page. *If you wish to be considered for both the Warren-McLeod Annual Award and the Warren-McLeod Summer Fellowship, you need submit only 1 application. Specify which fellowship(s) you are applying for on the application cover page. 	
Application Deadline	Submit application materials to the Boston University Marine Program (bump@bu.edu), by the application deadline, February 15, 2017 .	
Oral Presentation	Candidates for the annual award will present a 15-minute talk describing their research to the Selection Committee. The talks, which will be organized in a mini-symposium and open to the public, will be scheduled for the week of February 20,2017 .	If you are <i>only</i> applying for the Summer Research fellowship, you are not required to give an oral presentation.
Selection of Awardees	The Selection Committee will announce the winner of each award by March 1, 2017. In exceptional circumstances and contingent on funding, the committee may select more than one winner for either or both awards in a given year. The selection committee comprises the BUMP Director, the Chair of Biology, and one ad hoc member selected after the submission of applications. In the event that either the BUMP Director or Biology Chair is the primary advisor of a student in the competition, a substitute member of the selection committee will be chosen.
