This new navigation has a modern look and feel and will save you time with simpler workflows and easier access to important information.

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
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
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What's New?

The **Ultra Base Navigation** is a modern, intuitive navigation menu that lives outside of courses. From the moment you log in, you have access to core features in the menu where your name appears. You can easily return to the menu from wherever you are—even if you're in a course. The menu appears in the background of the other layers you have open. The Blackboard dashboard that you first see when you login will be updated. Your Blackboard courses will not change. They will look and operate exactly as they do now.











Pre-Competency Self-Assessment

– this **non-graded** self-assessment measures a learner's self-ratings on the competencies covered by this certificate program and takes about 10-15 minutes to complete. Please complete this self-assessment in one sitting. Upon submission of this self-assessment, learners will get access to Course 1. To begin this self-assessment, click on the title.

To load the pre-competency self-assessment, click on the title.

Click **Begin** to complete the precompetency.


After you complete the self-assessment, click **Submit**. Click on **Homepage** on the left menu to return to the homepage. You should now have access to the first online course.



All learners must complete a graded course quiz, and a total of five quizzes for a **certificate program**. The minimum passing score is 70%, and a leaner has up to 10 attempts to pass a quiz. The course grade will be released immediately after submitting the course quiz.

To load a quiz, click on the **quiz** title. After you click on the title, click on **Begin** to load the course quiz. Follow the same steps to retake the course quiz.

Post-course Competency Evaluation


