



## Undergraduate Student Association Award

### Overview

The College of Arts & Sciences Undergraduate Student Associations are encouraged to apply for the 2008-2009 CAS Undergraduate Student Association Award for excellence. The award will support and encourage outstanding Undergraduate Student Associations that demonstrate innovation, excellence, and dedication to the spirit of the liberal arts and mission of the student organization.

The CAS Undergraduate Student Association Award will be presented to an official student organization that demonstrates leadership abilities, enhances academic and student life, and illustrates public, community or government service as it relates to the spirit of a liberal arts education.

### Eligibility

Applicants must be full-time, Boston University College of Arts and Sciences students and members of an official CAS Undergraduate Student Association.

### Criteria

Applications will be judged on the following criteria:

- >> How the Undergraduate Student Association has met its own mission.
- >> How the Undergraduate Student Association has enhanced the academic and intellectual life of the larger CAS community.

### Application Process

To apply, complete the following application and include at least one letter of recommendation and a brief essay (1-2 pages) describing the organization's activities and contribution to the intellectual community in CAS. Applications must be returned to the Office of Student Programs & Leadership in CAS Room 130 no later than January 31, 2009. Award winners will be announced in March 2009. Late or incomplete applications will not be accepted. The CAS Student Services Award Committee will review applications.

### Award Value and Conditions

A total of \$1,000 in award money is available for the academic year. The \$1,000 may be awarded to one CAS Undergraduate Student Association or divided among several associations.
