DESCRIPTION OF FEES

Application Fee: This amount is required to process applications. The application fee and tuition deposit are non-refundable and non-transferable.

University Fees: This amount consists of a \$60 Community Services/Program Fee and \$60 Student Services Fee charged to all students.

Student Health Insurance Plan (SHIP): All students are required to have health insurance. In the fall semester, this amount provides BU's Student Health Insurance Plan (SHIP) coverage for the fall, spring, and summer semesters. For the spring semester, this amount provides BU's Student Health Insurance Plan for the spring and summer semesters. For the summer semester, this amount provides BU's Student Health Insurance Plan for the duration of the summer program.

Room/Meal Plan*: Students may choose to live in Boston University housing. The amount quoted here is based on costs for a shared room (two or more students) in a dormitory-style residence. Depending on availability, some students may be assigned other accommodations, which may cost more. All students living in dormitory-style housing are required to have a meal plan. Several plans are offered and the amount for Full-Time programs is based on 14 meals/week. You may choose a plan with 10 or 19 meals per week alternatively. Summer Dining Plans DO NOT include Convenience Points. Students may purchase Convenience Points and use them at various on-campus locations at an additional cost. For more details about Convenience Points, please refer to the BU Housing website: <http://www.bu.edu/housing/dining/convenience/>. Students are not required to live on-campus. This is an estimated expense that is used for immigration (I-20) purposes. Room/Meal Plan rates for Summer 2024 are not yet final and are subject to change.

Personal Expenses:** This estimated amount includes costs for books, supplies, and other miscellaneous expenses. Your actual expenses may differ. This is an estimated expense that is used for immigration (I-20) purposes.

Total Estimated Expenses for I-20 Purposes*:** Students applying to a full-time program must provide financial/bank documents that match or exceed the total estimated expenses of the program they are applying for to receive an I-20 Certificate of Eligibility.
