Registration for the Fall 2008 semester began on
Wednesday April 2, 2008

Registration Procedure:

1. Consult the Undergraduate Programs Bulletin, CFA Graduate Bulletins, or CFA website at www.bu.edu/cfa to review your degree requirements and the Fall 2008 class schedule on-line.
2. Put together a tentative schedule.
3. Complete a WebReg worksheet, making sure you sign it.
4. See your advisor to review your schedule. Have your advisor sign your WebReg form.
5. Visit your school office to obtain your advising sticker. Your advising sticker lists an advising code which you must have in order to register via the Studentlink.
6. Register online at www.bu.edu/studentlink. Double check to be sure you have officially registered for all classes before you log off!

**** Please note:** Courses with low enrollment at the start of the fall 2008 semester may be cancelled. Make sure you register during the registration period to avoid having a class you want to take cancelled.
