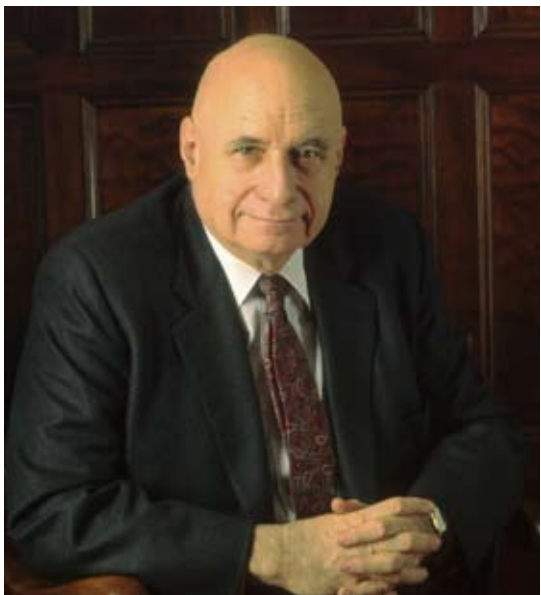

Professor Berger is probably best known for his work in the sociology of knowledge, especially in *The Social Construction of Reality*. He is also frequently cited for his articulation of secularization theory in *The Sacred Canopy*. Having since publicly and humorously retracted the latter claim, Professor Berger has been at the forefront of interpreting the place of religion in

modern culture for the past several decades. This includes his leadership of the Institute on Culture, Religion and World Affairs at Boston University, a research center committed to systematic study of relationships between economic development and sociocultural change around the world. There is no more profound voice to delve into the global state of religion in the world today.
