

Communication Minor

PRE-REQUISITE: Students must complete COM CO 201 with the appropriate grade (C or better) BEFORE declaring a minor. The student must have the Mass Communication, Advertising and Public Relations department sign off on the COM Minor Form after pre-requisite course is completed.

Students will have to maintain a GPA of 2.0 in all courses taken toward the COM minor.

Communication encompasses three focus areas:

- Communication Studies
- Advertising
- Public Relations

Six required courses (not including COM CO 201) in total.

Two Required Courses:

CM 331 Writing for Communication

AND

CM 321 Mass Communication Research -OR- CM 380 Theory & Process of Communication

Plus four, 4-credit 300 level or higher courses in COM CM.

Students will have to be aware of any pre-requisites when registering for classes.

Effective Fall 2011. Students enrolled in the College of Communication may minor in another department in COM. Additionally, non-COM students who have previously declared a COM related minor have the option to either complete that minor with the former requirements or to declare the new minor.
