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Students must complete COM CO 201 with the appropriate grade (C or better) BEFORE declaring a minor. COM CO 201 has a pre- requisite of First-Year Writing Seminar. Students will declare the minor through their home school AFTER receiving the minimum grade in COM CO 201.
