Undergraduates

The **John Koch Scholarship** provides an annual scholarship to COM undergraduates on the basis of merit to students in ADLAB. Scholarship amount varies.

The **Nathan H. Miller Award** provides an annual scholarship to a full-time COM junior working on the University's daily newspaper on the basis of excellence and financial need. Scholarship amount varies.

Bruce Feirstein Scholarship Fund provides an annual scholarship award based on merit and financial need to one or more undergraduate students enrolled at COM, with a preference for students who show promise in expressing their creativity through writing. Scholarship amount varies.

The **Steve Hill Scholarship Fund** provides annual scholarships to COM undergraduate students on the basis of merit and financial need. Scholarship amount varies.

The **Stern Spector Prize Fund** provides an annual award to an incoming or graduating senior majoring in journalism. Students are selected based on merit. Scholarship amount varies.

James N. Carfield Scholarship provides for a senior specializing in sports journalism. Scholarship amount varies.

The Stephen James Lilly Scholarship - two year scholarship award to one or more juniors in good standing enrolled at the College of Communication, on the basis of merit first, then need.

Graduates and Undergraduates

The **Nancy S. Druker Scholarship** is awarded to a deserving undergraduate or graduate student on the basis of academic achievement and financial need. Scholarship amount varies.

The **AJ Gray Scholarship** is given to a graduate or undergraduate student on the basis of academic achievement and financial need. Scholarship amount varies.

The **Gerhart D. Wiebe** and the **SPRC Scholarship funds** provide awards to COM students. Scholarship amount varies. Merit and financial need.

Max Grossman Scholarship Fund income is to provide a scholarship award in Professor Max Grossman's name to an undergraduate or graduate student in journalism at the College of Communication. Scholarship amount varies.

Hearst Corporation Scholarship in Memory of James F. O'Donnell provides an annual scholarship awards based on merit and/or need to one or more undergraduate or graduate students majoring in Mass Communication, Advertising and Public Relations at the College of Communication. Scholarship amount varies.

Marcy Syms Scholarship is awarded each year to two outstanding women in the Public Relations **graduate** program.

The **David Brudnoy Graduate Scholarship Fund** shall provide an annual scholarship award to an outstanding **graduate** student enrolled in broadcast journalism.

The **Ted Koppel Graduate Minority Scholarship Fund** shall provide an annual scholarship to an outstanding **graduate** minority student.

The **Richard W. Douglass Scholarship Fund** is to be used for scholarships for students in the Journalism department, with a preference given to those candidates from the family of ministers.
