



MET POLICY FOR COM STUDENTS

College of Communication students who have attained **junior or senior status** may take up to four MET courses (no more than one per semester). **These courses may count for electives only.**

The following actions are exceptions for juniors and seniors via an approved petition:

- If a student wishes to take a MET class to count toward a CAS concentration, the student must submit a petition to their department for approval.
- If a student wishes to count a MET course as a foundation (freshmen/sophomore) requirement, a petition may be submitted to COM Student Services for approval.
- If a student wishes to use a MET course to fulfill a minor requirement, the student must have the course approved by the school offering the minor and document the course on an updated minor declaration form.

Other information to consider:

- Communication related courses may not be taken at MET toward COM major requirements.
- Students who have completed a CAS equivalent course may not retake a class in MET (i.e. CAS PS 101 and MET PS 101).
- Students who have been suspended or who are on a leave may not take MET courses.
