These personal accounts are in two different "voices." The first is a selection of recovery stories that were published in the Coping With column of the *Psychiatric Rehabilitation Journal* from 2000 through 2008. The second "voice" is a collection of Photovoice projects—each project includes a photograph and a short narrative explaining the personal meaning of the photograph from the photographer's point of view. These inspirational contributions remind us that recovery is not only possible—it is real.
