INTERNET COURSES: PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM (PDP)

- Self-paced, online courses in psychiatric rehabilitation adapted from the Rehabilitation Counseling Program at Boston University's Sargent College of Health and Rehabilitation Sciences.
- Participants earn PDP hours for successful completion of the Internet courses by demonstrating their acquisition of knowledge through the completion of a competency test.
- There are no educational prerequisites for taking the PDP Internet courses. Individuals with varied backgrounds and experience are welcome.

PDP 606 Rehabilitation of Persons with Psychiatric Disabilities

Course Instructor: Cheryl Gagne, ScD candidate

PDP hours: 60

Examines the essential principles and knowledge base for the developing field of psychiatric rehabilitation. Exposes participants to the application of psychiatric rehabilitation technology in mental health systems and programs. Emphasis is placed on professionals' and consumers' lived experience of rehabilitation. Participants acquire their knowledge through online lectures and assigned readings.

PDP 608 Psychological and Social Aspects of Psychiatric Disability

Course Instructor: LeRoy Spaniol, PhD

PDP hours: 60

Provides information on the psychological and social aspects of psychiatric disability. Develops an understanding of the experience of the person, the impact of the environment on the person, the impact on the family, how the person copes and moves forward, the barriers and facilitators to this process, and the spiritual dimensions of recovery.

PDP 703-Rec Facilitating The Recovery Workshop

Course Instructor: LeRoy Spaniol, PhD

PDP hours: 45

Teaches participants how to use The Recovery Workshop to help people with psychiatric disabilities increase their knowledge, skills, and supports. The course has both knowledge and experiential components. First, using the Leader's Guide, participants learn how to facilitate The Recovery Workshop— learning the nature and purpose of this particular group process, and how the group impacts on the ability of people with psychiatric disabilities to cope and empower themselves. For the experiential component, participants are asked to set up a recovery workshop in their own community using the guidelines specified in the course. Consultation on setting up and running the workshop is available.
