

Undergraduate Research Mentoring

GSDM would like to increase its participation in undergraduate research mentoring under the Undergraduate Research Opportunities Program UROP. The Office of Research encourages faculty mentors to advertise research opportunities on the UROP website www.bu.edu/urop under <http://www.bu.edu/urop/students/on-campus-opportunities/> <http://www.bu.edu/urop/faculty/post-an-opportunity/>

Applications for UROP support are put together by the student and the mentoring faculty (you can find a link to the application on the front of UROP page). Applications are reviewed by the UROP Faculty Advisory committee, on three cycles yearly (fall, spring and summer).

Faculty Matching Grants (half provided by UROP; half provided by the faculty mentor) are as follows:

- Fall or Spring Semester: Up to \$2000 for 15-20 hours per week
- Summer: \$4200 for 35-40 hours per week for a 10-week program

GSDM is ready to help participating faculty if no funding is available.

The deadlines for applications are as follows:

- Fall 2013 will be due on September 18th at Noon
- Spring will be due by mid-December
- Summer will be due by mid-March

Students who do volunteer research or do research for academic credit do not qualify for funding.
