Your name must appear on the check; if your name is not printed on the check or money order, write your first and last name neatly in the memo area on the front. Note the program on the check (Advanced Standing DMD).
- 4) International applicants must provide a copy of their passport page including the photograph and name. A student's name must be set up in the Boston University system *exactly* as it appears on the passport, in order to comply with visa and immigration regulations. International students must submit additional materials as outlined in the acceptance letter, including the International Student Data Form.
