Student Health Services & Clinical Compliance

Please visit the [Medical \(MD\), Dental, or Clinical Graduate Medical Sciences Program Entering Student Requirements page](#) on the Boston University Student Health Services (SHS) website. If you are not yet in compliance with the Boston University requirements for inoculations and TB screenings, you can obtain immunizations and TB screening through Boston University Student Health Services for a fee. To make an appointment, please call SHS or log online via [Patient Connect](#) at least one week in advance, or attend the TB clinics scheduled on the Medical Campus (these clinics *only* offer TB screenings). You will need to return to SHS for your TB test reading 48 to 72 hours after the test implant: please plan accordingly.
