MA, MAEP and MAGDE students cannot fail more than two courses in their entire program; BA/MA and MA/MBA students cannot fail more than two courses in the graduate economics part of their programs.
- 2. MA, MAEP, MAGDE, MA/MBA and BA/MA students must pass the core comprehensive exam prior to graduation. No deferral of taking the MA Comprehensive is permitted.
- 3. A student enrolled in three to four-and-a-half courses (12-18 credits) will be considered full-time and will be charged full tuition and fees.
- 4. BA/MAs should see the undergraduate advisor for questions regarding their undergraduate degree.

In order to receive the diploma at the traditional May Commencement, the MA Comprehensive should be taken and passed by the January offering in advance of the Spring semester. If the MA Comp is taken and passed at the end of the Spring semester, then graduation is in September, and the diploma will be received after September 25^{th.}
- 6. MA/MBA's must file two separate graduation applications to receive the MA and MBA degrees. The MA and MBA degrees will be conferred concurrently after completion of both.
- 7. BA/MAs must file two separate graduation applications to receive the BA and MA degrees. The BA and MA degrees will be conferred concurrently after completion of both. Receipt of the actual BA or MA diploma is dependent on the timing of completion of the MA Comprehensive exam. In order to receive both diplomas at the traditional May Commencement, the MA Comp should be taken and passed by the January offering in advance of the Senior Spring semester. If the MA Comp is taken and passed at the end of the Senior Spring semester, then graduation is in September, and both diplomas will be conferred after September 25th.
