**Sports Pass

The Sports Pass will automatically be charged to your student account if you are a full-time Charles River Campus student. The Sports Pass will allow you admission to 18 home men's ice hockey and 18 home women's ice hockey games as well as 11 home men's basketball and 11 home women's basketball games (a \$350 value). You may deduct the Sports Pass charge from the balance you remit if you list the cancellation on your invoice stub.
