## **Medical Care Contact Information - ROHP**

Research Occupational Health Program (ROHP) was established last year to provide medical care to laboratory personnel in the event of an injury or illness in the laboratory.

► Major Medical Emergency: including heart attack or seizures

Below are a few scenarios in which you would need to contact ROHP for evaluation.

- ► Lab Exposure: including needle-sticks, cuts, scratches, or splashes
- ► Animal Bites: including animals which have been infected with any hazardous agents
- ► Unexplained Symptoms or Illness

The ROHP 24/7 line will connect you with the BU Research Occupational Health Program medical officer. ROHP will then refer you to the appropriate health care location (see below).
