## Glass Disposal Boxes MUST:

## Be securely closed.

This means taping them tighly using **duct tape** or **packing tape**.

Lab tape and scotch tape are not sufficient.

## NOT be over-filled. — -

3/4 full is a good rule of thumb, especially for boxes which are densely-packed with small items.

Custodians will not remove boxes which are too heavy to safely lift or are poorly closed.

## Be non-hazardous.

Chemical, biological and radiological wastes do NOT belong in these boxes.



These boxes are in place as a safety measure to protect our custodial staff by keeping potentially sharp glass and plastic from the regular waste baskets.
