

# Hazard Probability Chart

PROBABILITY	OUTCOME
<b>FREQUENT</b> (A)	<b>Occurs very often or is continuously experienced.</b> As an example: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. <i>Individual student</i>—Occurs very frequently or always occurs while performing tasks or operations.</li> <li>b. <i>Group of students</i>—Occurs continuously during tasks or operations.</li> <li>c. <i>Equipment</i>—Occurs very often in service life or expected to occur several times over the duration of tasks or operations.</li> </ol>
<b>LIKELY</b> (B)	<b>Occurs several times.</b> As an example: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. <i>Individual student</i>—Expected to occur during period of work, specific tasks or operations.</li> <li>b. <i>Group of students</i>—Occurs at a high rate, but experienced intermittently.</li> <li>c. <i>Equipment</i>—Occurs several times in service life. Expected to occur at specific tasks or operations.</li> </ol>
<b>OCCASIONAL</b> (C)	<b>Occurs sporadically.</b> As an example: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. <i>Individual student</i>—Occurs some times in period of work, tasks, or operations, but NOT often.</li> <li>b. <i>Group of students</i>—Occurs sporadically (irregularly, sparsely, or sometimes).</li> <li>c. <i>Equipment</i>—Occurs some time in service life. May not occur during specific tasks or operations.</li> </ol>
<b>SELDOM</b> (D)	<b>Remotely possible or could occur sometime.</b> <b>Not expected to occur during a specific task</b> As an example: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. <i>Individual student</i>—Isolated incident during period of work, task, or training. Remotely possible, but not expected to occur during a specific training or task.</li> <li>b. <i>Group of students</i>—Occurs rarely within exposed population, but more likely as isolated incidents.</li> <li>c. <i>Equipment</i>—Occurs in service life, but only remotely possible.</li> </ol> <b>Not expected to occur during a specific task.</b>
<b>UNLIKELY</b> (E)	<b>Can assume will not occur, but not impossible.</b> As an example: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. <i>Individual student</i>—Occurrence not impossible, but may assume will not occur during period of work, task, or training.</li> <li>b. <i>Group of students</i>—Occurs very rarely, but not impossible.</li> <li>c. <i>Equipment</i>—Occurrence not impossible, but can assume will never occur in service life.</li> </ol>
