The Student Elections Commission received the following complaint from Blyss Buitrago at 1:12PM on April 22, 2012, assigned reference number six:

Alex Michel has been sending emails to the co-ed fraternity Alpha Phi Omega, without sending a carbon copy to the SEC and without including the disclaimer at the end so that students are aware of their rights if they have received more than 2 emails from their slate. ---> Violating EC 3.4.11

After consideration of the complaint, the SEC has issued the following ruling:

Upon receipt of three examples of such emails, sent to members of Alpha Phi Omega, the Marine Science Association, and Student Volunteers for Special Needs, the SEC finds with a 5-1 vote that the BAAAM slate has violated EC 3.4.11 because of a failure to include election@bu.edu in the Cc line or include the appropriate disclaimer. The slate will be charged 20 violation points per infraction (EC 6.3.13).
