The Student Elections Commission received the following complaint from an anonymous student at 9:55 PM on April 12, 2011, assigned reference number 3:

I witnessed Rhettvolution harassing students at the top of Warren Towers escalators. It is against Lifebook code to campaign or promote in dining halls.

After consideration of the complaint, the SEC has issued the following ruling:

Based on the evidence submitted by the complainant, the SEC finds with a 4-0 vote (2 abstentions) that no violation of the elections code has taken place. The area outside of security on the fourth floor of Warren Towers is clearly not inside a dining hall. Further, the Lifebook does not expressly prohibit campaining or promoting in public spaces.
