Requirements for a Minor in Electrical Engineering or Computer Engineering

1. A minor in electrical engineering or computer engineering can be earned through completion of 20 credits selected from among all ENG EC courses at the 300-level or above. Students may also use ENG EK 307.
2. No more than 8 credits can be used to satisfy the student's major degree program requirements.
3. Students are expected to obtain the necessary background (prerequisites or equivalents) to complete their chosen minor program.
4. Students must have a declared major on record in order to apply for a minor in Electrical Engineering or Computer Engineering.
5. No minimum GPA is required to apply for the minor.
6. The grade point average (GPA) of the courses (20 credits) used to for the minor must be 2.0 or greater for the minor to be awarded.
7. The student's application and the choice of minor designation (electrical engineering or computer engineering) are subject to the approval of the Associate Chair for Undergraduate Studies of the Department of Electrical and Computer Engineering.

The following courses overlap too much for credit to be given for more than 1 course in each of a-f below. However, these courses can be used to satisfy Minor requirements subject to the 8 credit double count limit. Students are expected to complete the course appropriate to their major.

- a) ENG BE 401 with ENG EC 401
- b) ENG BE 402 with ENG EC 402 or ENG ME 403 or ENG ME 404
- c) ENG BE 420 with ENG ME 307 or ENG ME 309
- d) ENG BE 436 with ENG ME 303
- e) ENG EK 424 with ENG ME 304
- f) ENG BE 200 with ENG EC 381 or ENG ME 308
