## **Requirements for a Minor in Mechanical Engineering**

1. A minor in mechanical engineering can be earned through completion of 20 credits selected from among all ENG ME courses at the 300 and 400 level. ENG EK 301 may also be used. Some ME designated courses at the 500 and 700 level may also be used by petition.
2. No more than 8 credits can be used to satisfy the student's major degree program requirements.
3. Students are expected to obtain the necessary background (prerequisites or equivalents) to complete their chosen minor program.
4. Students must have a declared major on record in order to apply for the Minor in Mechanical Engineering.
5. No minimum GPA is required to apply for the minor.
6. The grade point average (GPA) of the courses (20 credits) used to for the minor must be 2.0 or greater for the minor to be awarded.
7. Applications for the Minor in Mechanical Engineering must be approved by the Undergraduate Committee of the Mechanical Engineering Department.

The following courses overlap too much for credit to be given for more than 1 course in each of a-f below. However, these courses can be used to satisfy Minor requirements subject to the 8 credit double count limit. Students are expected to complete the course appropriate to their major.

- a) ENG BE 401 with ENG EC 401
- b) ENG BE 402 with ENG EC 402 or ENG ME 403 or ENG ME 404
- c) ENG BE 420 with ENG ME 307 or ENG ME 309
- d) ENG BE 436 with ENG ME 303
- e) ENG EK 424 with ENG ME 304
- f) ENG BE 200 with ENG EC 381 or ENG ME 308
