Between 1940 and 1945, General Moravec served as the chief of the intelligence service of the Czechoslovak Government-in-Exile in wartime Great Britain. Moravec headed the planning and preparation of the assassination of Obergruppenführer Reinhard Heydrich, code-named *Operation Anthropoid*. After the defeat of Germany in 1945, Moravec returned to Czechoslovakia. He had to escape again, secretly, in 1948, after the communist takeover. He eventually settled in Washington, D.C., where he worked until his death in 1966 as an intelligence advisor in the Department of Defense.
