■ CHESTNUT STREET MEETING HOUSE

Boston University’s Preservation Studies program provided the first extended investigation of the Chestnut Street Meeting House in Millville, Massachusetts (Worcester County). BU scholars conducted historical research and archival organization, shedding light on the unique properties of the building, which was erected in 1769 and used for town meetings and social and religious events.
